### *From the Pastor's Desk*

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)  
June 7, 2026  
John 6:51-58

Dear Ascension Family,

Greetings of peace and good health! This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, commonly known as Corpus Christi. But before we enter into reflection on the Body and Blood of Christ, please allow me to share an important message from our Bishop, the Most Reverend Robert J. Brennan, to all the parishes in our diocese. It concerns how we, as a community of faith, will mark the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States.

To commemorate this important milestone and to reaffirm our faith and commitment to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Bishops of the United States will consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, on June 11, 2026. We have been asked to join in this consecration locally on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 12, 2026. Part of this consecration is the praying of the Novena to the Sacred Heart which we have started last Thursday, June 3, after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Moreover, Reverend Monsignor Joseph Grimaldi, Vicar General of the Diocese of Brooklyn and on behalf of Bishop Brennan, will celebrate Mass and Consecrate the Diocese of Brooklyn on Friday, June 12, at 12:00 PM at the Cathedral Basilica of Saint James, in union with the nation.

As part of this anniversary year, we are also encouraged to participate in special devotional practices such as Eucharistic Adoration and corporal works of mercy.

Let us now look at what the Eucharist is really about.

In the year 1330, a priest in Cassia, Italy was summoned to give Holy Communion to a sick person. Being in a hurry, he improperly put the sacred host between the pages of his prayer book. Arriving at the house of the sick person, the priest was shocked to see the sacred host full of blood. It was later found out that it was a miracle within a miracle: the profile of the face of Jesus could be seen imprinted in the sacred host. Up to this day, the sacred host is still preserved despite its exposure to natural elements.

About 500 years before this event - in the 8th century - a priest from Lanciano, Italy doubted the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. He was shown a miracle when during the consecration of the Mass, the bread became flesh, and the wine turned into real blood. In 1970, a scientific investigation was conducted by an illustrious scientist named Odoardo Linoli, an eminent professor in Anatomy, Pathological Histology, Chemistry, and Clinical Microscopy. by Prof. Ruggero Bertelli of the University of Siena. Their analyses sustained the following conclusions: the Flesh is real flesh; the Blood is real blood; the Blood contained proteins in the same normal proportions as are found in the sero-pretic make-up of fresh normal blood; the preservation of the Flesh and Blood - without any chemical preservatives and exposed to the action of atmospheric and biological agents - remains an extraordinary phenomenon. What is very interesting in the findings is that the Flesh was found out to come from the muscular tissue of the heart: the myocardium.

The aforementioned miracles of the Eucharist - there are many others - are telling us that the Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Christ, and as such cannot but awaken our consciousness of the importance of the Eucharist. In today's gospel reading, Jesus declares, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Eucharist is not just about what happens at the altar in every Mass. It is about how we live our lives each day.

There is a unique law of biology when it comes to the Eucharist. When we eat normal food, that food breaks down and becomes a part of us. But when we eat the Eucharist, **we become what we eat.**

We leave the church transformed into a living tabernacle. When we go home, when we go to work, and when we interact with other people, we are carrying Jesus inside us. The application to daily life is simple but staggering:

- + Our tongue, which received the Body of Christ, cannot be used for gossip or harsh words.
- + Our hands, which were extended to receive the body of Christ, must become Christ's hands to serve others.
- + Our heart, which at Holy Communion is united with the Sacred Heart, must beat with Christ's love and compassion.

When the priest closes the Mass by saying, "**Go forth, the Mass is ended,**" he is not just letting us go. He is sending us out as a missionary. We have been fed by Christ, now we go out and feed the starving world with his love.

**St. Rita of Cascia**  
May 22

Rita of Cascia was a wife, mother, widow and member of a religious community. Her holiness was reflected in each phase of her life.

Rita was born in 1371 at Roccapiorena in central Italy, the only child of older parents. She wanted to become a nun but her parents informed her that they had already chosen the man she was to marry. Seeing this as God's will, Rita married the man her parents had chosen and together they had two sons. Her husband turned out to be very abusive and cruel toward her as well as her sons. After a difficult twenty-year marriage, her husband was stabbed to death in a brawl. She told her sons to forgive his murderers and not seek revenge but they didn't listen and were themselves murdered shortly afterward.

Rita wanted then to become a nun but the convent refused her because they thought she might bring the local vendetta with her into the convent. Rita managed to reconcile the families of her husband and his killers and was then allowed to enter the convent. She was a nun for forty years spending her life in prayer. For the last fifteen years of her life, she was given the gift of a Christ-like wound on her forehead. She had known the sufferings of Christ in her life. She was understandably devoted to meditation on Christ's Passion.

Rita's great strength is shown not only in her long-suffering patience. Her strength is shown in the fact that she never succumbed to the culture of violence, resentment and revenge that surrounded her. She always sought to be a peacemaker, a bride builder, a sower of the seeds not of division but of peace. Women with marital problems came to her for advice and comfort. Parents with difficult and quarrelsome children also came for her wisdom and prayer. She was so effective, that she is known in our time as the patroness of impossible cases. She is honored in Italy as a female "St. Jude."

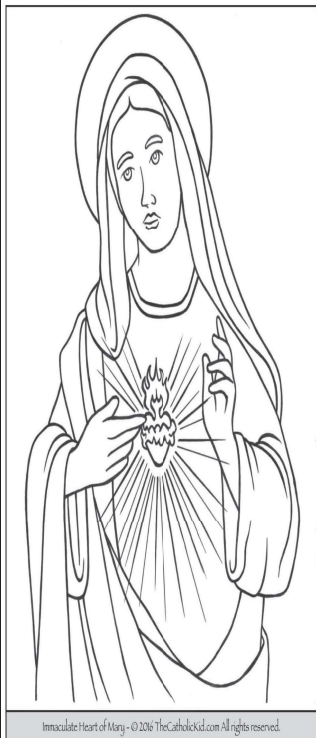
